Program Overview:

Through the 1Million Project, Sprint and the Sprint Foundation will help close the homework gap by providing free devices and wireless service to schools to connect 1 million low-income high school students (over a period of five years) **who do not have home internet access.**

The 1Million Project will help level the playing field so that low-income high school students will have access to the technology they need to succeed in school, participate in the digital world and reach their full potential.



Eligible High School Students Will Receive:

- 3 GB per month of free high-speed LTE data while on the Sprint Network. Unlimited data is available at 2G speeds if usage exceeds 3 GB in a month
- A free smartphone, tablet, laptop or hotspot device
- Free hotspot capability and unlimited domestic calls/texts while on the Sprint Network for students who receive a smartphone
- Free Children's Internet Protection Act compliant content filter with every device. This filter blocks adult content and malware while on the Sprint Network. This filter is always on, cannot be disabled and was specifically designed for the 1Million Project
- Up to four years of free Sprint wireless service, depending on eligible high school student's grade level when they begin the program

There are 5 million U.S. families with school-aged children who have no home Internet.

Repeat each year through school year 2021-22

Program Requirements

High schools and school districts must meet the following requirements:

- Commitment to be enrolled in the program throughout its five year duration
- Identify and support a minimum of 1,500 eligible students (300 per year) over the five year program duration who do not have home internet access. Schools must validate this with students/parents
- Manage the parent/guardian consent form process
- Place annual device orders
- Assign a dedicated Program Manager responsible for overall program success
- Assign a local resource such as a teacher or counselor at each school to facilitate program requirements and effectiveness at that location
- Manage device inventory including storing devices in a secure location
- Provide program feedback to Sprint
- Engage locally and nationally as a program champion, communicating program details, collecting and sharing student impacts, etc.

Program Milestones

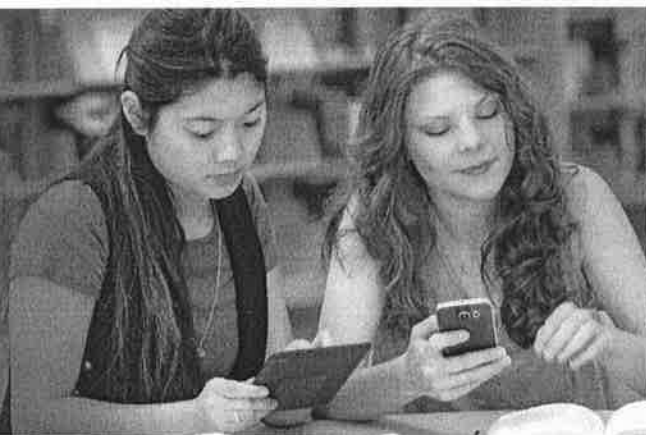
To continue in the program year-to-year, schools must meet all program requirements as well as the following annual milestones:

- Attend a pre-activation webinar which prepares schools for activating and distributing devices to eligible students
- Attend webinar trainings as offered
- Host and manage an Activation Day where schools activate and distribute devices to eligible students
- Meet minimum device activation and usage criteria
- Provide quarterly student eligibility updates
- Complete surveys from Sprint
- Administer surveys to the member students and families
