## CETPS Students Participate in Design Challenge

During the 2018 BEYA Conference, AMIE (Advancing Minorities' Interest in Engineering) hosted its first ever Design Thinking Challenge. The AAMU team, consisting of Abebe Anchebe, Ivan Embden, Virag Hollos, Michael Land and Kidist Zergaw, competed against 10 other HBCUs. The competition was to design an app that can assist college students and recent college graduates market their skills and abilities to various companies and organizations in lieu of the traditional resume.
