JOHN STALLWORTH SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION GUIDELINES

The John Stallworth Academic Scholarship Foundation awards two scholarships based primarily on scholarship merit, financial need and evidence of leadership. The TYPE I Scholarship is granted for one academic year in the amount of \$1,000.00. The TYPE III Scholarship is payable for four years as long as the student maintains eligibility. The scholarship award is \$1,000.00 per year. When a student falls below the minimum grade point average for the TYPE III scholarship, he or she will be informed that he or she is no longer eligible to receive the scholarship. In extreme cases should the recipients of the TYPE I or TYPE III scholarships fall short of funds needed for books, course fees, etc. consideration will be given for additional funds with the show of the appropriate documentation. All required application materials, including copies of admission's acceptance letter, official high school transcript, counselor report, letter of recommendation, and essay must be filed with the Office of Development and Alumni Affairs, Alabama A&M University in time for submission to the Board of Directors, John Stallworth Scholarship Foundation, Incorporated by May 1.

TYPE I SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD CRITERIA

1. Must be a United States citizen.
2. Must be a graduating high school senior and in good standing who has been accepted at A&M University.
3. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 and attained a score in the 50 percentile on the college entrance examination (ACT or SAT).
4. Must possess leadership qualities in high school, church or community activities.
5. Must provide high school principal or counselor report form and at least one letter of recommendation from community leader (e.g. pastor, teacher, etc.).
6. Must submit an essay on why he or she should be awarded the scholarship and future career goals.
7. Must submit a copy of admission's acceptance letter to Alabama A&M University.

ESSAY CRITERIA

3. What are his/her future goals after college?
4. How will you assist Alabama A&M University and its students after graduation?

TYPE III SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD CRITERIA

1. **Must be a United States citizen.**
2. **Must be a graduating high school senior and in good standing who has been accepted at Alabama A&M University.**
3. **Must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.30 or better and score at least 21-23 on the ACT or between 990-1070 on the SAT.**
4. **Must maintain a 3.30 or better cumulative grade point average while in attendance at Alabama A&M University.**
5. **Must possess leadership qualities in high school, church or community activities.**
6. **Must provide high school principal or counselor report form and at least one letter of recommendation from community leader (e.g. pastor, teacher, etc.).**
7. **Must submit a an essay on why he or she should be awarded the scholarship and future career goals.**
8. **Must submit a copy of admission's acceptance letter to Alabama A&M University.**
