Items for Removal:

- 1. Is the contractor required to remove all objects, fixtures, and debris left remaining in the building are to be disposed of as part of the contract. Yes, the contractor is responsible for the items as discussed during the pre-bid walk through.
- 2. Are all bathroom fixtures and appliances are to be removed. This includes the bathtub and toilets. The owner will remove the claw foot tub and the pedestal sinks, all other bathroom fixtures shall be handled by the contractor.
- 3. Are all Mechanical HVAC units and ductwork is to be removed. Yes
- 4. Are all closet fixtures, paneling on walls are to be removed. Yes all wood and cedar ato be removed by the contractor.

- 5. Are all specialized wood framed ceilings in the 1980's addition are to be removed. Yes
- 6. Are the double door entries on the South and East side of the 1980's addition are to be removed, including frame. (E.g. Brick-to-brick) Yes, and the exterior double doors, transoms & sidelites on the South and East side of the 1980's addition that get removed are to be secured with exterior grade plywood.
- Exterior bay windows on the North an South 1980's addition will be removed, including frame. (E.g. Brick to Brick) Yes, Exterior double doors, transoms & sidelites on the South and East side of the 1980's addition that get removed are to be secured with exterior grade plywood.

#### Items for Preservation:

- 1. All exterior residential windows are to be preserved. Contractor is responsible for protecting the windows.
- 2. All commercial skylights and clerestory windows of the 1980's addition are to be preserved.
- 3. All tile floors in the building are to be preserved. This includes bathroom floors.
- 4. All fireplaces are to be preserved by installing plywood enclosures.
- 5. Electrical outlets, wall devices and baseboard heaters are to be preserved.

**Building Security and Protection:** 

- 1. Exterior doors are to remain affixed and secured to the building.
- 2. Damaged exterior residential windows, which are <u>not</u> to be removed, will be covered from the inside of the building using exterior grade plywood cut to fit securely.
- 3. All hardwood floors will be protected from damage during demolition.
- 4. The grand staircase in the main entrance is to be protected with plywood. This includes Stair Treads, Risers, Arm rails, and Balusters.
