## MINIMUM MANDATORY SANCTIONS FOR ALCOHOL AND DRUG VIOLATIONS

---

### FIRST FINDING OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Notification of parent/guardian(s) regarding violation(s) for students under the age of 21
- Completion of 3<sup>rd</sup> Millennium online education course(s): Marijuana 101, Under the Influence or Other Drugs (\$60 fee paid by student)
- (10) hours of community service
- Disciplinary probation, one semester minimum
- Fine of \$40

### SECOND FINDING OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Notification of parent/guardian(s) regarding violation(s) for students under the age of 21
- Mandatory participation in Alabama A&M University's Alcohol and Substance Use Group Series. A Student who fails to satisfy the sanction requirement in the specified time may be charged with an additional violation of the Student Conduct Code.
- (20) hours of community service
- Disciplinary probation, two-semester minimum
- Housing privileges permanently revoked
- Fine of \$150

### THIRD FINDING OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Notification of parent/guardian(s) regarding violation(s) for students under the age of 21
- Suspension/expulsion from the university, one semester minimum
- Evidence of substance abuse counseling or other appropriate learning and development activity while away
- Disciplinary Probation, two-semester upon return
- At the discretion of the University Code Administrator, a fine of \$500 may also be imposed.

### IMPORTANT NOTES

- The amount of alcohol and/or drugs in student's possession may impact mandatory sanctions (quantities under 28 grams/1 ounce of drugs will follow prescribed sanction recommendations)
  - Suspension from the university for a semester for a moderate to serious violation committed
  - Student may be placed on Suspension for two or more semester or expelled for repeated or serious violations
- Additional Notifications:
  - If a student is a varsity athlete—the athletic coach and Athletic Director notified
  - If a student is a member of a SGA, SAB, Royal Court, Yearbook, and/or a Greek organization, Director of Student Activities and Leadership Development notified
- Judicial Status will reset each academic year after completion of sanctions. However, past behavior and findings may impact future sanctions
