



PRAXIS POP UP IS A HIT!

Dominique Roberson, a "Write Place" tutor presented a Praxis workshop in February. Roberson, a junior English Education major who has passed the test already was able to offer her personal knowledge and experience to fellow Education majors who have yet to take the required exam. In less than an hour, Roberson provided students with resources, tricks and tips that will help them to succeed. This workshop allowed students to ask their questions among peers, in a relaxed, informal environment.

Elementary Education major, Arriana Richardson, was one of the many education majors in attendance. "I feel like this workshop was really helpful. Having this information from a fellow student who has passed the Praxis helps me to be more prepared for it."

The Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators Praxis tests assess pre-service educators' basic skills and knowledge in reading, writing, and math. The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) requires these tests and students must pass before registering for professional studies education courses here at Alabama A&M. After passing the Praxis Core, students must, then, pass what is called the Praxis II, a subject specific test determined by a student's major/concentration. Students enrolled in Communicative Sciences and Disorders are required to take the Praxis test for Speech Language-Pathology. Upon successful completion of these exams, students receive the desired bachelor or master's degree along with a teaching or speech therapy certification. Alabama A&M offers a Praxis Core class and free testing material through the Praxis Lab located in Carver Complex North 206.
