MAKING A DIFFERENCE

WE HAVE SERVED OVER 870 STUDENTS FOR THE SPRING 2019 SEMESTER!!

Students come to The "Write Place" for various reasons, often as part of a class. Thirty percent of the students who have come over the past two months came with their whole class to work collectively on an assignment. In these instances, tutors work along-side teachers to assist students as they complete their writing work.

Teachers also bring their classes to the Center so that students can see where we are and learn more about the services we offer. After coming here with their class, many return for one-on-one assistance. Thirty-one percent of students come to The "Write Place" to work independently on their writing or other homework, and thirty-nine percent come, either to attend our subject-specific workshops, or to work with a tutor.
