- ✓ Study and intend to pursue a career in environmental science, forestry, ecology and wildlife, plant biotechnology, urban & regional planning, fashion design, fashion merchandising, hospitality management, general dietetics, human development and family studies, food science, or animal bio-health sciences
- ✓ Maintain at least a 2.8 GPA each semester while receiving scholarship support
- ✓ Enrolled as a full-time student, registered for a minimum of 12 credit hours
