Internships for Course Credit in the Department of Food & Animal Sciences

Students must:

Obtain advisor's approval for enrollment in FAS 405, FAS 491 or FAS 605 Submit internship documentation (acceptance letter for internship) Complete online Internship Opportunity Report (http://tinyurl.com/o5krbj4)



Complete a minimum of 10 hrs per week (40 hrs/month) for a minimum of 2.5 months (total of 100 hrs)

Maintain contact with course instructor (every two weeks)

Provide a written report (5 pages minimum) AND a presentation (oral or poster) as part of the course requirements

Mentors must:

Submit an internship opportunity or acceptance letter to the intern or to the Department Complete the online form at the completion of the internships

Advisor must:

Approve of the student's opportunity prior to approving of course enrollment

To qualify as an internship opportunity, it does not have to be a paid position and must begin after May 1, 2015.
