

Expanding E-Learning in STEM (Online Asynchronous Course Developer) 2021-2022

All STEM faculty are invited to apply for the opportunity to participate in the expansion of e-Learning courses, minors, and programs. This activity seeks to expand e-Learning in STEM programs to promote access and opportunity for students pursuing academic programs and careers in STEM areas.

The focus of STEM Course Developer Year 2:

1. Develop and certify e-Learning courses which support STEM majors, up to the 400 level

In summary, STEM Course Developer participants will:

- 1. Select a course of your discipline
- 2. Deadline to develop one course per year*
 - November 15th for Spring Semester
 - March 15th for Summer Semester
 - May 15th Fall Semester
- 3. Complete Online Course Request Form

4. Must attend (1) course development training

Things to Remember

- 1. Pre-record your lectures.
- 2. YOU must PROVIDE instruction, do not outsource a tremendous amount of YouTube.
- 3. You can use YouTube, but it should not exceed the amount of instruction from the course developer.
- 4. Recommended maximum 15-20 minutes per video recording.
- 5. The course must include 12-15 hours of instruction, for a 12-week semester.
- 6. eLearning labs and various resources are available to reserve
- 7. All developers have instructional priority of the course, for two years.
- 8. The Online Course Request Form is not an MOU
- 9. You cannot develop over 25% of your major in online courses
- 10. Participants are eligible for a stipend up to \$1000.
 - a. \$800 (with third party tool used)
 - b. \$1200 (without third party tool used)
