Given this information, the Office of Financial Aid will allow students to increase their cost of attendance by a total of \$2500 for any 3-year period.

- The adjustment does not have to be done at one time. You can purchase equipment as you need it.
- The adjustment may or may not result in a change in the amount of financial aid you receive.
- Any increase in aid will be in the form of loans. For PLUS loans, parents must pass a credit check.
- Additional funds offered will be available beginning May 15, 2006 after all paperwork is processed.
