

[1003] 2018–2019 Verification Worksheet

Your 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you and your parents reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the Financial Aid Administrator (FAA) at your school will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the FAA at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your FAA as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed. **WARNING**: If you purposely give false or misleading information on this worksheet, you may be fined, sentenced to jail, or both. The law states that AAMU has the right to ask you for information before you are awarded any financial aid. See the instructions in the FAFSA. AAMU must review the requested information (C.F.R. Title 34, Part 668, the student financial aid rules).
