CRITERIA/REQUIREMENTS

- Must reside outside of the state of Alabama.
- Must be fully and unconditionally admitted as a full-time/first time freshman for the Fall 2017 Semester.
- Must have a Composite Predictive Index, (CPI) Score of 20 or higher upon acceptance. The Composite Predictive Index is calculated during the admissions process.
 - (Cumulative High School GPA + *Composite ACT Score = CPI)
- Must have paid all required 2017 Fall semester enrollment and orientation fees required of entering freshmen.
- Must have successfully completed the FAFSA, if applicable.
- If selected for verification during the FAFSA process, must have satisfied all verification requirements before receiving this award.
- > The recipient of this award in combination with other institutional or federal aid (excluding student or parent loans) cannot result in a cash refund being awarded.
- Recipients of this award are being notified via email effective December, 2016.
- > To maintain this award, recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 and must complete a minimum of 30 hours per academic year.

*Composite ACT or equivalent SAT Composite score.
