



## Academic Standing Levels



Good Standing (GS) - is achieved by earning a cumulative gradepoint average of 3.0 or higher.



- Graduate Probation (GP) - when the cumulative gradepoint average (GPA) falls below 3.0 and are above 2.5 or who fail to make academic progress
- Must restore GPA to 3.0 within nine additional semester hours of graduate work including repeated and dropped courses.
- Failure to do so may result in dismissal.



- Academic Dismissal (AD) - when the cumulative GPA falls below 2.5 in any given semester
- HOLD placed on student account
- Must complete and submit Graduate Action Plan
- Must meet with advisor

## APPEALS

A student may wish to submit a [Graduate Academic Action Plan](#) to appeal the academic dismissal if the student believes their dismissal was the result of an administrative error or if the student can offer compelling reasons for their academic standing. This request must include a personal statement explaining the student's poor academic performance and showing the compelling reasons why the student should be allowed to continue. The student may be asked to meet in person with School officials. The decision reached by the School in response to an appeal is binding.
