To assist with your educational experience; our office employs a residential life program which nurtures and engages students in learning outside the classroom. Our office works diligently to provide quality and comfortable living accommodations to make your stay as convenient as possible.

For the 2022-2023 academic year, Mamie L. Foster Living/Learning Complex will offer a non-traditional option for its freshman male and female students. Freshman female students will be housed in the East Wing of Foster Complex, and the freshman male students will be housed in the West Wing. Traditional housing options for freshman male and female residents will include the following:

Applications for the 2022-2023 academic year will open at 9:00 am on May 2nd, and close on July 31, 2022, at 11:59 pm (CST), for First-Year Students or until we reach capacity. For new students to apply for housing, you must meet the following criteria.

- You must be accepted to Alabama A&M University before applying for housing.
- You need a 2022-2023 FAFSA on file with Financial Aid before applying for housing.
- You need to pay the Enrollment Fee of \$115 before applying for housing.
- A \$350 housing fee is required to complete the application process. The fees include \$100 nonrefundable application fee, and \$250 refundable deposit.
- Go to <u>myAAMU</u>, click on the Single Sign-On (SSO) Account Log-In. Look for the Student tab and click the link. Under the Student tab look for the Housing Application link, click on it and Apply.

To assist with setting up your new room, we have compiled a <u>list</u> of suggested items to bring with you to the Residence Hall. For a complete list, please refer to the Guide to Campus Living.
