

Waitlist Q&A

1. **I am a transfer student. Can I apply for the waitlist?** No, the waitlist is for UG returning students only.
2. **I am a graduate student. Can I apply for the waitlist?** No. We do not have any available space for graduate students. This process is only for undergraduate returning students.
3. **I have not registered for my classes. Do I need to have a class schedule to apply for the waitlist? Do I need a current FASFA? Do I need to have a deposit on file?** If you do not meet the criteria for housing, you are not eligible to apply.
4. **I tried to apply for the waitlist but it is not allowing me to do so.** First, the waitlist opens July 13th. Secondly, if you do not meet the criteria for housing, you will not have access to the application.
5. **Can you check to see if I have everything taken care of like my FASFA, deposit and classes?** I am sorry, housing will not be able to verify that information for you. We were able to do so earlier in the semester. However, at this late date you should have your business in order.
6. **Can you give me more time to take care of my business?** The process opens July 13th and closes July 16th.
7. **I want a single room?** Special requests will not be considered. Special requests include the following:
 - Building preference
 - Floor preference
 - Roommate request
 - Room type
8. **I paid my money and still did not receive an assignment.** Completing the application and paying the \$100 non-refundable fee makes you eligible to be added to the waitlist. Which means, you are not guaranteed to receive a room assignment. You will be assigned a room based on your application timestamp.
9. **How do I access the application? The directions were sent in a separate e-mail. Please review those directions.**
