# Youth Motivation Task Force Program

The YMTF program provides professionals from various backgrounds – many of whom are AAMU alumni – an opportunity to interact with students and to introduce them to careers within the private and public sectors. Teams of two to five professionals will speak with classes virtually where they share career advice, trials and triumphs, words of wisdom and encouragement. Through their personal and professional accomplishments, YMTF consultants show students, first-hand, the rewards that can be gained from earning a college degree.



### Outreach Program Goals:

- Introduce AAMU students to careers in the private and public sectors
- Advise students on possible solutions to problems they might encounter in the workplace
- Inform students about the technical and soft skills they will need to succeed in the workplace
- Share experiences about working in a professional work environment
- Serve as positive role models and mentors at all times
- Underscore to students the importance of being fully engaged with Career Development Services (CDS)

### Outreach Impact:

- Create or alert CDS to possible employment opportunities (internship, co-op, career) for AAMU students
- Develop mentorship opportunities
- Increase awareness of CDS and its services to students and faculty
